1. Students must provide: **a)** this completed agreement, **b)** a valid drivers' license, **c)** proof of insurance, **d) the \$20 annual fee (only \$10 after spring break)**. Permits may be re-issued for a change of vehicle, at no charge, provided the old sticker is returned, if old sticker cannot be returned a second permit will cost \$10.
2. Permit should be affixed on the front windshield, inside lower right-hand corner. Permits on motorcycles should be affixed on the rear fender.
3. Students may park only in the general student parking lot located on the southwest part of the property in the lots outside the PAC and athletic areas.
4. Students parking in the front parking lot or Faculty Parking areas are strictly prohibited and will be ticketed and/or immobilized (booted). Current ticket and "boot removal" prices are listed below.
5. Students are encouraged to secure their vehicles as well as locking valuables out of view. The school will not be responsible for theft or damage.
6. All parking lot incidents should be reported to our Security or the SRO.
7. Issued permits constitute an agreement between the school and student/car owner that vehicles will be parked in designated parking spaces and are subject to search by school officials or the SRO for reasonable or probable cause.
8. Student parking on campus is a privilege and all students are expected to comply with all safety, moving and parking regulations. Violations will result in consequences leading up to and including loss of privileges and immobilization of vehicle.

No Permit - Citation \$25, Parking in non-student areas - Citation \$10

Immobilization (boot) removal * - \$20

- Vehicles get immobilized on the 3rd "no permit" offense. Citations are compounded, so it usually costs approx. \$95 to get the boot removed if the citations are unpaid. **The boot will be removed only after the permit is purchased and the citations are paid.**
- The parking area located behind the cafeteria is not available to students as our Band practices on it from August until sometime in December and is used as morning and end of day staging for School Busses.
- Temporary parking permits are available to students that have valid parking permits, but have driven a different vehicle to school due to various situations, i.e., car being worked on or used by someone else. These may be obtained through the school Security office.
- There is no loitering before, during or after school in the parking lot.
- **WHS administration reserves the right to boot a vehicle for any violation!**

1. Complete the Student Parking Permit Agreement with all requested information and signatures.
2. Include a photo-copy of the following with your completed agreement:
 - a. A valid driver's license
 - b. Proof of insurance
3. \$20.00 permit fee must be included. Make checks payable to Weiss High School.
4. **Turn in all documentation in person to Mrs. Brown in the Class of 2020 office – D103.**
5. **Permits may be obtained before school or during power hour only beginning August 20, 2018.**
6. **Citations will be issued for non-permit vehicles beginning September 4, 2018.**

Please read the permit agreement completely before turning in your paperwork. By obtaining a parking permit, you agree to all terms and understand that parking on campus is a privilege that can be revoked.
