ATTENDANCE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Because of strict state guidelines, students must be in attendance for 90% of the possible days for each session. • Attendance that is less than 13.5 of the 15 day session will result in a student not earning credit. Students will not recover the course if they are absent more than 6 hours per summer school session, which is equal to 1.5 days of attendance. • Any time spent outside of class due to tardies is accumulated and counts as an absence.
